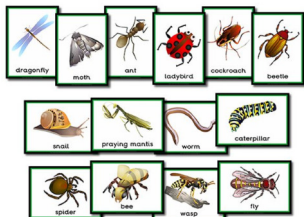
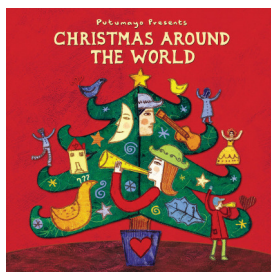

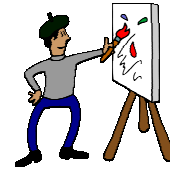

LVPS Behaviour Ladder

If children go above and beyond what is expected of them, they would receive 10 house points and a praise note home to inform parents of their success.

Children can be moved up again for making excellent choices and earn 5 house points.

Children can be moved up for making good choices and earn 3 house points

Everyone starts the day on green.

Children are given a verbal warning if they are not respecting the rights of the class. If it continues, children will be asked to move their peg onto the 'Stop, Listen and Think' zone and will be encouraged to reflect on their behaviour.

If the behaviour persists, another verbal warning is given. If there is no improvement, an appropriate consequence will follow. It may simply be a chat with the class teacher, with parents at home time or a loss of 5 mins golden time. However, there may be occasions where support would be sought from the S.L.T.
